There was action a plenty up and down the 26 car grid and I don't think there was a face without a smile at the end of the weekend!

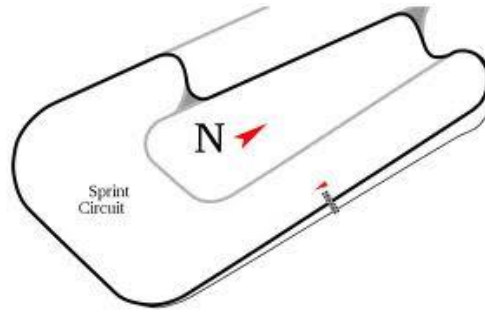
This year's event promises to be as good as every other and we need **you** to make sure this happens...beg, borrow, tell lies if you have to but whatever you do, don't miss out!!
